

NOTICE FOR IPRC KITABI STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019

The Integrated Polytechnic Regional College (IPRC) Kitabi, formerly known as KCEM (Kitabi College of Conservation and Environmental Management) is a Higher Learning Institution with the mandate to build and develop capacity in Conservation and Environmental management in Rwanda and the wider Albertine Rift Region. The college offers diploma programs in Wildlife Management, Wildlife Tourism and Forest Resources Management. It also offers different short courses relating to conservation, environmental management, tourism, etc.

LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE

IPRC Kitabi is located in Southern Province, Nyamagabe District, Kitabi Sector, on the outskirts of Nyungwe National Park. From Kigali, IPRC Kitabi is approximately at 185km and with public transport, passengers are advised to take Kigali-Rusizi buses and stop at Kitabi, near the entrance of Nyungwe National park. For passengers from DRC (South Kivu), the college is a bit close to the town of Bukavu (DRC) and Rusizi District (Rwanda) approximately 126km. Passengers from Rusizi can take the bus Rusizi-Huye and stop at Kitabi (near the exit of Nyungwe National Park).

INFORMATION ABOUT THE REGISTRATION

Following the academic year 2018-2019 starting soon, IPRC Kitabi is pleased to give the following information to continuing and new students:

1. The academic year 2018-2019 at IPRC Kitabi is starting on 22nd October 2018.
2. The registration dates are from 4th October to 19th October 2018.

3. The registration fee and other requirements for registration for the first and the second year are indicated by the office of Rwanda Polytechnic (RP).
4. Beside the registration fee paid at RP account, IPRC Kitabi students in year one are required and requested to pay 26,000Rwf for the field uniform. This amount will be paid on the account number **484435918810175** entitled **IPRC KITABI STUDENTS COUNCIL** opened in **BPR**.
5. Every student is requested to come with his own boots for field activities.
6. Students are also advised to come with raincoats and jackets, because the place is cold and rainy.

N.B.

- Students who don't fulfill all the requirement are not received.
- Having boots and raincoats for field activities is an obligation for the 1st year students.
- IPRC KITABI has accommodation for only female students. The cost is **5000Rwf per month**. The college has also a restaurant for students, where users pay **18,000Rwf per month**. Those who wish to use the college accommodation or the restaurant pay on the account number: **002850 694514 137** entitled **KCCEM Guest House** opened in **Bank of Kigali**.
